Greetings to all from the Board of Directors of the St. Louis Camp Meeting Association of the Church of God! We sincerely hope that this letter finds you safe, and in good health.

The last few months here in Michigan have certainly been very trying, with the COVID-19 pandemic, and more recently, the flooding which has overtaken much of mid-Michigan.
